

CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

Ege Fren adopts ethical and sustainable practices in its supply chain, acting with a sense of environmental and social responsibility. In this context, our commitments and practices for the responsible sourcing of conflict minerals such as Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, and Gold (3TG) are as follows:

- Not sourcing directly from mines located in Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (CAHRA),
- Fully complying with UN sanction decisions and local legal regulations,
- Supporting our suppliers and business partners in adhering to the same standards,
- Requiring our suppliers to complete the "Conflict Minerals Reporting Template" (CMRT) developed by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) and share it with Ege Fren,
- Verifying whether smelters in our supply chain are approved under the "Responsible Minerals Assurance Process" (RMAP),
- Ensuring our suppliers comply with Ege Fren's Code of Ethics and Business Conduct,
- Monitoring our suppliers' compliance with national and international regulations on conflict mineral sourcing,
- Tracking suppliers' due diligence in sourcing minerals from high-risk areas.

As Ege Fren, we are committed to supporting sustainable and responsible mining practices in our supply chain and continuously improving our performance in this area.
